

Rascal Captain Jack Sparrow (Johnny Depp) is back with a serious battle on his hands. Not only is he fending off the corporate greed of the East India Company, who want to seize his pirate plunder and put an end to his roguish ways, he's also being stalked by something far more sinister—Davy Jones (Bill Nighy) has arisen from the

ocean's depths to collect the debt owed to him by Cap'n Jack—Jack's soul in eternal servitude in Jones' watery home. Being the trickster he is, Jack once again embroils Elizabeth Swann (Keira Knightley) and Will Turner (Orlando Bloom) in his escapades, interrupting their wedding and leaving a trail of mayhem wherever he goes. Is Jack a pirate villain who has put Will in mortal danger or a pirate hero who will in the end save everyone, including himself? You'll want to see this film at least a dozen times this summer, because it's got the sly sense of humour and solid storytelling chops of the first *Pirates*, not to mention over-the-top special effects—Davy Jones, his ship and *soooo* much more—and absolutely amazing action sequences—I held my breath through the wild watermill wheel scene AND Jack's dodgy "dance" with "his" tribe. The good news is they've already shot the third sequel and it's set to hit screens next May. The bad news is there's a wicked little twist at the end of *Dead Man's Chest* that has me on my knees begging for those scurvy studio knaves to release it now...
